Dislodged Spring






The spring has a rubber gromet that attaches to the handle. The spring and rubber gromet are not intended to stop the handle when released. The user should always use their hand to slow the release of the handle.

If the spring becomes dislodged using a small screwdriver it can easily be put back into place. Ensure the small end of gromet is exposed from the spring (Picture A). Then guide it into the handle (Picture B).


